RESOLUTIONS:

The 13th Board of Studies meeting of Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences (Autonomous) was held on 21.12.2023 from 04.00PM to 05.15PM through Google Meet online platform **Google Meet Link:** https://meet.google.com/iov-fiqi-yri and discussed the proposed agenda and made the following resolutions:

Prof. Rama Rao Nadendla, Principal, Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, welcomed members of 13th Board of Studies in Pharmacy, presented brief report of the institution on academic, co-curricular, extracurricular and developmental activities.

- Following the 12th BOS held at Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, in May 2023, six resolutions addressing curriculum enhancements, seminars, conferences, and quizzes were discussed and implemented.
- The academic activities for B.Pharmacy/M.Pharmacy/Pharm.D programs for the academic year 2023-2024 are currently in progress, and all examinations for the preceding academic year (2022-2023) have been completed.
- Over the span of seven months, the institute showcased with the publication of 27 research papers, (10 in Web of Science (WOS) and 5 in Scopus-indexed).
 During this period 05 faculty awards, one guest lecture were delivered.
- Faculty members contributed significantly by authoring three books and five book chapters, while students also made valuable contributions.
- Five skill development programs, including the noteworthy Barclays Rubicon, were organized to enhance practical expertise.
- The institute organized three national-level conferences on diverse themes, conducting two webinars, and organizing 11 guest lectures.
- Furthermore, the institution actively participated in International Yoga Day and celebrated the National Pharmacy Week.
- A workshop and training program, including hands-on sessions on Pelletization and Film Forming, an online workshop on intellectual property rights and patents, and a campus drive on medical coding, demonstrated the institute's commitment to holistic education. Additionally, the establishment fostered industry-academia collaboration by signing three Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) with Solution 3X, Greyhound Chromatography and Allied Chemicals, and Leo Global Overseas.
- 06 Career guidance sessions, 14 awareness programs, 02 industrial visits, and a national pharma quiz added further dimensions to the institute's comprehensive approach to education and skill development.

- The Sir Ram Nath Chopra Memorial Lecture on "Antimicrobial Chemotherapy
 Past, Current, and Future Trends" highlighted the institute's dedication to
 staying abreast of advancements in the field. 25 outreach activities were
 organized and benefitted 2316 people.
- Overall, the report underscores the Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences' commitment to excellence in education, research, and holistic development.

While appreciating the academic and research activities being carried out by the Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical sciences, members suggested to emphasize on the following topics to be incorporated in the curriculum. Introduction to AI, types of aerosols, operation and application of aerosols, clearance, volume of distribution, softwares for pharmacokinetic studies, integration of ChatGPT in various aspects of pharmacy.
