
To coordinate research, teaching, extension and other academic activities of the department.

Course from the academic year 2016-17.

1. Syllabus, regulations, scheme of Instructions, scheme of examinations, question paper for I/VI Pharm.D and I Pharm.D (PR) will be followed as per the regulations of Pharmacy Council of India: guideline for Pharm.D Programme.
2. The board has approved panel of external examiners (Theory/Practical) for university examinations of I Pharm.D and I Pharm.D (PR) courses.
 - a. M. Pharmacy qualification with 5 years of teaching/industrial experience (at managerial level) will be considered for I Pharm.D.
 - b. For Pharm.D (PR) 1st year, it is resolved to approve external examiners (Theory/Practical) with M. Pharmacy (Pharmacy Practice/Pharmaceutics) Pharm.D, Pharm.D (PR) with Ph.D with 5 years of teaching/research/industrial experience (at managerial level) will be considered for appointment as an external examiner for the academic year 2016-17.
3. It is resolved to approve syllabus, number of hours and regulations of Certificate course in Pharmacovigilance to be implemented for V and VI Pharm.D/II and III Pharm.D (PR) courses from the academic year 2016-17. (copy enclosed)
4. a. It is resolved to approve the guidelines of Journal club Meeting and Patient counselling to be implemented for IV, V and VI Pharm.D / I, II and III Pharm.D (PR) Course from the academic year 2016-2017. (copy enclosed)

- b. It is resolved to approve the dissertation guidelines for V Pharm.D / II Pharm.D (PB) course from the academic year 2016-17. (Copy enclosed)
- c. It is discussed and resolved to conduct some of the innovative teaching methods such as case based teaching, Pharmacist rounds in the hospital, training of pharmacy students in emergency medical conditions.
- d. It is resolved to plan for Interprofessional education model for further improvement in / learning and evaluation pattern, and also resolved to conduct open book examinations and objective type examinations to assess the performance of the student.
- e. It is resolved to organize Home Medication Review (HMR) (once in two months), Health awareness camps (once in two months), organizing health camps with government organizations, provide Patient counselling (daily basis) to meet societal needs.
- f. It is resolved to enrich the teaching learning process by flipped classes (min. 25%), Power point presentations (min. 20%), video presentations (min. 20%), supposive classes (10%), Quality Enhancement of teaching (10%) and student seminars (10%) for I Pharm.D and I Pharm.D (PB) from the academic year 2016-2017.
- g. It is resolved to discuss theoretical & practical concept using model / charts / specimens / software to enrich the curriculum for I Pharm.D and II Pharm.D (PB) from the academic year 2016-2017.
